The NE corner of the Robeson Rolling Mill and the <u>waterwheel's paddles can be seen on the left side</u>, with water flowing out of its tail race (red circle).

Farther up on the left is a Saw Mill.

The bridge crosses 'Ridge Road,' known as Ridge Turnpike In 1816.
